How to Play:

Print and Cut out game boards and playing cards. Each player gets a board and cards are put in one stack.

Player 1 draws a card. The Alphabet Queen wants to hear the name of all her letters so they must say the letter name they draw! If they don't know, feel free to help out!


Player 2 repeals the same process.


When a player draws a picture card they get to collect it on their board, and play continues with the next player. The player to collect the queen, her crown and her jewels first is the winner!
